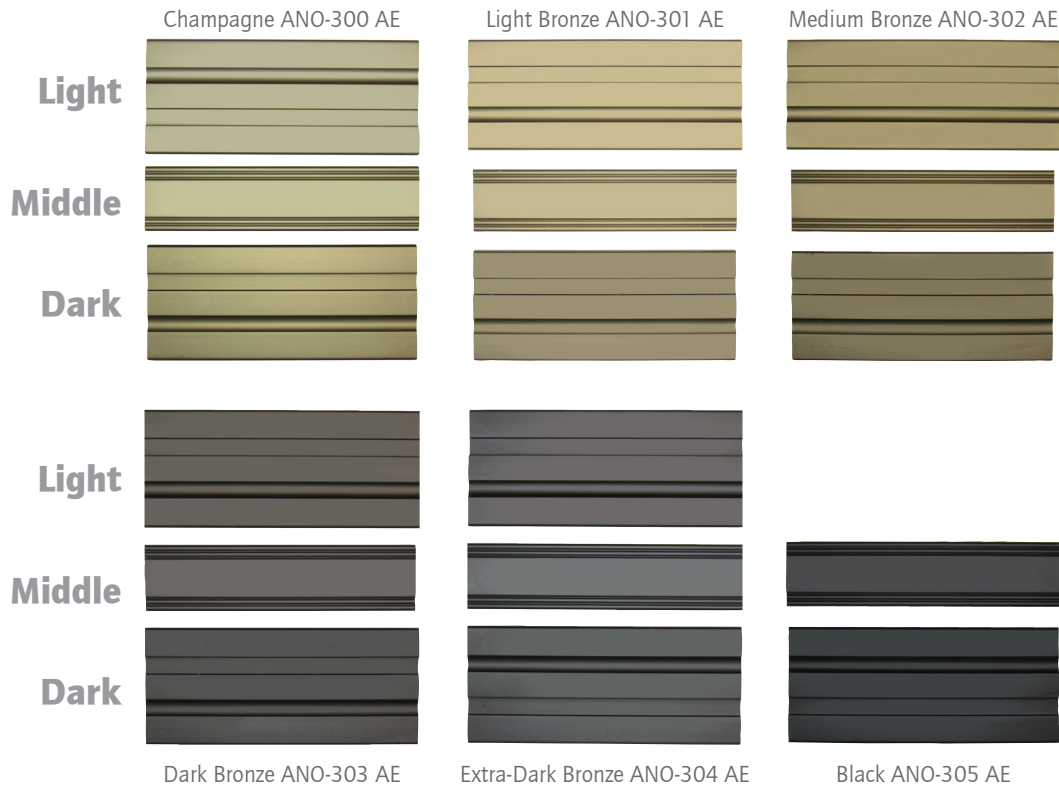


Anodized Color Range

Anodized color shades can vary from batch to batch due to numerous variables that are part of the anodizing process. The pictures below depict that range. The "middle" is what the target shade is and what is shown on our Finish Options Card (2901415). However, the actual production can range from the "light" to "dark" as shown below for each color. The entire range, as shown below, is an acceptable outcome of the anodized process.



Powder Coat Alternative

Raynor's ArmorBrite™ powder coat option offers six anodize equivalent colors listed to the right. ArmorBrite powder coat offers several advantages over anodizing:

- Shorter lead times – by several weeks
- Easier touch-up – anodizing is extremely difficult to match
- Hides surface imperfection that will be seen through anodizing
- Large selection of color options – ArmorBrite offers 187 different colors
